Quantification



EDGE is an entirely quantitative green building standard. Each measure selected corresponds to a percentage improvement across different resource-efficiency categories compared to a local baseline.

Standardisation

The baseline in EDGE is calculated using a standard methodology, meaning that companies and investors can take a standardised approach across a portfolio of buildings around the world.



Comparability



There are local baselines available in EDGE for every country in the world, making it possible to accurately compare the resource efficiency of buildings across countries and continents.
